
Compressed, rolled gauze is ideal for wound bandaging and wrapping of injuries.





Direction to Use Compressed Gauze

- Step 1: Pull 6 to 8 inches of packing material out from the initial pack
- Step 2: Probe the wound gently to check for shrapnel, find the source of bleeding and apply pressure
- Step 3: Feed the pack into the wound until you reach the end of the wound
- Step 4:When the wound is completely packed, apply pressure for ten minutes if no compression bandage is available
- Step 5: Apply a trauma bandage to keep the gauze in place
